
St. Francis Day, Pets & Animals, Blessings & **Nature**

"The Scottish poet Kenneth White, in his poem writes, 'I open the book and the words fly out of the page.' The book that he is referring to is Creation." -J. Philip Newell

Every year we have the option to recognize and celebrate St. Francis in some way in early October around his saint's day. One of the most important examples St. Francis left us was the way that love of Creation, nature and animals fits into our Christian life. In St. Francis' Day it was common to divide what was holy (church, prayer, sacraments, Scripture) and what was profane or common (animals, agriculture, nature, everyday things and issues).

St Francis in his life broke up this tendency to put animals and nature as not being spiritual or holy. Whether it was caring for songbirds, wolves, rabbits

or doves- the care St. Francis took animals drew people's attention to the importance of animals. His example made people notice that animals are loved by God and are part of the Creation we are charged to care for. So over time it has become the custom of the church to remember St. Francis

by blessing animals, since he reminded us how they are loved by God.

St. Francis likely saw the world in the way the poet wrote above. In the stories we have of St. Francis, he responded to the natural world seeing God at work in the sun, the moon, light and shadows and in his fellow human beings. When others would pass by lepers and people with other contagious diseases- St. Francis recognized them as people who were part of God's Creation and loved by God. We sometimes forget too that he crossed over to the Muslim world to connect and share the love of Christ with people who were supposed to be his enemies too.

Wherever St. Francis went he was always opening the book of God's creation and marveling at the words which flew off the page. When we remember St. Francis, we remember the marvel, wonder and respect which he had for God and for the people and animals he met.
